Please allow this correspondence to serve as a formal request for a complete list of all locations that the County is considering for a possible sewage effluent recharge system within the Town of Smithtown. I am aware of the Nissequogue River State Park site, but I am also aware that the State has requested that the County exhaust all possible alternatives before this parkland can be utilized. As such, please forward not only all the locations presently being identified for possible use, but any past locations that have been considered and/or any known future locations the County is planning to analyze.

Attached for your files, please find documentation identifying as state parkland the areas where the county is currently conducting soil borings, specifically, the Nissequogue River State Park.
